All Horses must be registered with ARHA.

Horses may be registered at the show (see show management)

All owners and exhibitors must be current ARHA members

All classes will be judged according to ARHA rules

Stalls and camper hook-up are on a first come, first serve basis

Western attire required for all classes, long sleeved shirts, hat and boots.

Horses should be shown as naturally as possible. No banded manes, artificial tails, hoof polish or silver tack should be working tack.

Class entry fee: \$12.00

Added money classes entry fee \$ 20.00

Payback \$125, \$75, \$50

*** Cattle classes \$20 cattle charge, plus entry fee ***

Office fee \$ 6.00 per horse

All Day Youth and Amateur fee \$75.00

1 horse, 1 rider combination (plus cattle charges)

Stall fees \$25 per day or \$40 weekend

Jump out fee \$10 for unstabled horses

All overnight horse must be stabled
